



External Activity Risk Assessment

Phillip Island Camps @ The Island Accommodation is based in Newhaven, and provides group accommodation and can also coordinate activities for schools, groups and individuals.

As part of our commitment to safety, we have adopted a Risk Assessment Template for all externally provided activities. This assessment process provides persons in charge and camp organisers an opportunity to understand the potential risks and subsequent mitigation strategies to undertake.

Risk Assessment Criteria

Likelihood – This is the assessment of probability of an incident occurring that may lead to an injury **Consequence** – This is the severity of the injury

The risk assessment matrix identifies the relationship between likelihood and consequence, and identifies the Risk Level
